Thankfully school is out and we will have some time to get things back in order. Please pray therefore for the **3 T's** that are so vital to our ministry - **Teachers, Toilets, and Transportation!** We think we do have sufficient teachers for next year so that is a positive, but Brexit pales in comparison to not having transportation and toilets operational.

In May, we were able to attend Joseph's high school graduation at Pensacola Christian Academy. He made it on the President's list by scoring a 4.0 GPA. Pray for Joseph as he is doing an internship this summer at a church in Las Vegas. We are very happy to see his progress as a young preacher. It also brings us great joy to see our 2 girls Celina and Brooklyn serving with dedication in church; helping with Sunday School, bus routes, music, and the pharmacy. Julie and I believe that our children serving God is our greatest accomplishment on the field.



In June, we were able to host a mission team from Pensacola Christian College (without toilets on part of the property). Despite the inconveniences, the missions trip was a success.



We have learned since the trip ended, however, that 2 of the team members have contracted the Zika virus while in Honduras.
