After working more than 2 years in our ministry, the Rolston family left to move on to another ministry. They will be missed and the fruit of their labor will continue. We also lost one of the buses from our bus ministry but God has graciously replaced it so that we can continue our bus ministry.

The Seminary is going well and we are seeing growth and maturity in the preacher boys. We will continue raising funds to level the new Seminary property. We will begin our construction again in Jan after the rainy season and Christmas.

In Sept. Bro Byron Willis preached our yearly Bible Conference. It was a great blessing to all as Bro. Willis is one of the most powerful preachers in the Spanish speaking world. We were able to attend the Sword Conference on the north coast of Honduras with our Seminary students in September. These conferences are a great learning tool for us all.

Although it rained about the whole time they were here, we were able to pour a second floor, put sidewalks, wired lights, weld stairs, and many other tasks were accomplished.
