We have had a very good start to the school year for the New Life Bible college (17students), the Spanish Language Institute (3 students), and the Christian school (184 students). We are so grateful for the Christian school in that it allows us to offer work opportunities for the Bible college students. Otherwise, most of them would not be able to pay the cost. The school benefits the ministry in so many other ways as well. Most of the students are not from our church. This Sunday a student and his mother decided to visit and both made professions of faith. This doesn't happen often, but we have slowly gained members through our Christian school.

We have also contracted a bus to start a new bus route to another town about 20 minutes away. Counting bus workers and driver, we had 30 this Sunday. The 2 towns covered on this route are more populated than the town where we work. So we now run 3 buses and contract another. Praise the Lord that we are able to do this and that we have the motivated workers to do this. We have nearly 50 workers all total. We want to thank the churches and individuals this month who have contributed money to buy tires for our buses. I also want to thank my big brother Pastor Ledford Hodges who took it upon himself to contact pastors and put this need before them. My big brother has always looked out for me. Thank you for your prayers and support this month. May the Lord richly bless you.
