God! Joseph just turned 16 and is preaching, leading music and teaching. Celina, who is 14, teaches. Joseph, Celina and Brooklyn (12) all three work on the bus routes. We are so proud that our children want to serve the Lord along side us. Thank you for your prayers for our protection and your financial support.
