The church in Sabanagrande is doing very well. We have had quite a few vistors. We had about 40 visitors for Friend Day alone. The church in La Paz is moving forward, at least in attendance. Lots of kids are coming which really gets us excited. We hope to find a pastor for this work within the next year or so.
