We thank our Lord for not only taking care of us during the present crisis, but also for His bountiful blessings.

Joseph, our son graduated May 8, got married May 9 and was ordained June 27. It was definitely a busy two months for all of us.

We were able to return to Honduras on July 9. Because we were required to sign papers promising to quarantine for 21 days, we felt compelled to honor our signature. The 21 days passed rapidly and we are now out and running. We are continuing to have Sunday service and also meet on Wednesday. In the bus route areas further from our church, we are able to send teams to hold services as well. People are still being saved though much of what we are doing is illegal.

Our Christian school will be starting up September 1, but we will only be able to have it online. Because of this, the enrollment has plummeted and we will have to dismiss a large part of the school staff. It may take several years to recuperate our numbers in the Christian School.

The Bible college will also start back up on campus September 1. Please pray for this ministry as it is partially financed by the Christian School. God has been so good and gracious. We know that He will see us through.
